Part 1: School Overview

Early College High School and Pathway in Technology Early College High School are educational opportunities afforded to students by a partnership between Bastrop Independent High School and Austin Community College (ACC).

The Colorado River Collegiate Academy (CRCA) is an early college high school. Students attending CRCA take a rigorous course of study enabling them to earn an associate of art or associate of science degree from ACC at the same time they complete their high school diploma. CRCA offers a unique high school experience focused on academics and combines small class sizes with a cohort orientation.

Students enrolling in PTECH programming earn increasing degrees of industry credentials up to an associate of applied science degree from ACC, including an industry-based certification, Level I or Level II certificate, including work-based learning opportunities. Bastrop High School's PTECH is in Health Science and Cedar Creek High School's PTECH is in Advanced Manufacturing.

 The criteria for selecting students into the Colorado River Collegiate Academy or PTECH Academy are: The applicant must reside in the Bastrop Independent School District. The applicant must have been enrolled in BISD for all of the 8th grade year. The applicant must meet ALL requirements for promotion from 8th grade to 9th grade. The applicant must attend a two-week Summer Bridge Program in June of 2022. The applicant must have submitted the application for admission to his/her middle school counselor or CRCA principal by the deadline of March 28, 2022 for Early Decision or April 29, 2022 for Regular Decision. (Applications received after the deadline will be accepted but will be placed on a waiting list.) The applicant understands that competitive sports and fine arts are not offered at CRCA or through PTECH enrollment. The selection process includes: Completion of the application
A total of 90 students will be admitted into the CRCA Class of 2026. A total of 50 students each will be admitted to BHS PTECH and CCHS PTECH.
A lottery process will be used if more qualified students apply than the program is able to accommodate.
