Part 3: Important Information and Selection Process

The criteria for selecting students into the **Colorado River Collegiate Academy** are as follows:

- The applicant must reside in the Bastrop Independent School District.
- The applicant must meet ALL requirements for promotion from ninth grade to tenth grade.
- The applicant must complete the four admission essays as a part of this application.
- The applicant must go through an interview process with the staff of the Colorado River Collegiate Academy.
- Current 9th grade students must pass the TSI in reading and writing before May 15, 2020, and enroll in EDUC 1300 during the first ACC summer session.
- The applicant must attend a two-week Summer Bridge Program in June of 2018.
- The applicant must have submitted the application for admission to CRCA principal or counselor by the deadline of March 27, 2020. (Applications received after the deadline will be accepted, but will be placed on a waiting list).
- The applicant understands that competitive sports and fine arts are not offered at CRCA.

The selection process includes:

- Completion of the application and essays.
- Interview
- A lottery process will be used if more than 12 qualified students apply.
- A total of 80 students will be admitted into the CRCA Class of 2023 (There are currently 68)
