The criteria for selecting students into the **Colorado River Collegiate Academy** are:

- The applicant must reside in the Bastrop Independent School District.
- The applicant must meet ALL requirements for promotion from 9th grade to 10th grade.
- Current 9th grade students must pass the TSIA2 in ELAR before May 20, 2022, and enroll in EDUC 1300 during the first ACC summer session.
- The applicant must have submitted the application for admission to the CRCA principal or counselor by the deadline of March 28, 2022 for **Early Decision** or April 29, 2022 for **Regular Decision**. (Applications received after the deadline will be accepted but will be placed on a waiting list.)
- The applicant understands that competitive sports and fine arts are not offered at CRCA.

The selection process includes:

- Completion of the application

A lottery process will be used if more qualified students apply than the program is able to accommodate.
