Part 1: School Overview

Early College High School (ECHS) and Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH) are innovative educational opportunities afforded to students by a partnership between Bastrop Independent High School (BISD) and Austin Community College (ACC).

The Colorado River Collegiate Academy (CRCA) is an ECHS. Students attending CRCA take a rigorous course of study enabling them to earn an Associate of Art or Associate of Science degree from ACC at the same time they complete their high school diploma. CRCA offers a unique high school experience focused on academics and combines small class sizes with a cohort orientation.

P-TECH Academy students attend a comprehensive high school (BHS or CCHS) and take classes at ACC starting in 10th grade. P-TECH programming offers work-based learning opportunities each year in partnership with local businesses. Students earn industry-based certifications and an ACC Level I certificate. P-TECH program courses are cohorted to the extent possible.

The criteria for selecting students into the Colorado River Collegiate Academy, BHS P-TECH Health Science Academy or CCHS P-TECH Advanced Manufacturing Academy are: • The applicant must reside in the Bastrop Independent School District. • The applicant must have been enrolled in BISD for all of the 8th grade year.** • The applicant must meet ALL requirements for promotion from 8th grade to 9th grade. • The applicant must attend a Summer Bridge Program in June of 2025. • The applicant must submit the application for admission by the deadline of March 7, 2025 for Early Decision or April 25, 2025 for Regular Decision. Applications received after the deadline will be accepted and may be placed on a waiting list. (Submission options are at the bottom of this page) • The applicant understands competitive sports and fine arts are not offered at CRCA and may be unavailable to those enrolled in P-TECH Academies.
The selection process for each Academy cohort includes: • Completion of the application • Lottery process, if necessary
For the class of 2029, a total of 90 students will be admitted into CRCA; a total of 50 students each will be admitted to BHS P-TECH Health Science Academy and CCHS P-TECH Advanced Manufacturing Academy. A lottery process will be used if more qualified students apply than any program is able to accommodate.
