1. Opening

A. Meeting Called to Order

Chief Scot Bunch called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. A quorum of committee members was present.

B. Purpose of the Safety and Security Committee

Chief Scot Bunch spoke about Texas Education Code 37.109. In accordance with guidelines established by the Texas School Safety Center, Bastrop ISD has established a school safety and security committee, which is required to meet 3 times a year.

C. Adoption of the School Safety and Security Committee Policy

The committee members were given a binder with the School Safety and Security Committee Guidelines and the BISSD Emergency Management Standard Response Protocols.

2. Updates and Progress

A. Safety and Security Updates

Chief Scot Bunch updated the members on the security measures that have been implemented and the ones that are being considered. New Emergency Operations Plan to be updated by Texas School Safety Center (TxSSC) after January 1, 2020. Bastrop ISD will update District's EOP as soon as TxSSC releases model guidelines.

B. Required Training

Chief Scot Bunch presented information regarding required training for the committee members.

C. Progress on District Safety and Security

Chief Scot Bunch spoke about the progress of safety and security measures for the district.

The following is a list of progress:

- 4 new officers added in the 2019-2020 school year,
- 4 officers are (TLO) Threat Liaison Officers,
- 2 officers are (MHO) Mental Health Officers,
- 1 officer attended Gang Investigator Training,
- Stop the Bleed Stations have been installed on all campuses and other BISD offices/buildings.
- CRASE training has been offered at the campuses.

D. School Safety Audit

Information was given to the committee members regarding the School Safety Audit. The School Safety and Security Committee will assist with the audit. The period being audited is 2017-2020 and will be completed from April 1, 2020 – August 31, 2020.
