

Credentialing Credit with Advanced Placement Examination

In Bastrop ISD Advanced Placement Exams are available in Languages Other than English (LOTE). Students seeking to place out of language exams and receive high school credit must take the corresponding language exam without having any prior instruction in the subject.

Advanced Placement exams are available Chinese, French, German, Latin and Spanish. No other AP subjects are available for AP exam credentialing. For all other subjects and exams, students must also take the corresponding AP course along with the exam. To be eligible for credentialing exams students must register with their appropriate counselor. The student is responsible for the exam fee. There will be no GPA weighting applied to the corresponding high credential and if a student receives a passing score on the AP exam, the high school equivalent grade will be "P".

The table below explains AP Score Conversion for high school equivalency

3	Level 1 & 2 of corresponding language class
