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Are you at risk of not graduating?



- Things we look for...
 - Grades
 - Credits
 - Obligations
 - Attendance
- Senior teachers are monitoring grades
 - Weekly meeting with TorresMandatory tutorials,
 - Saturday School
 - Parent Meeting
- Students who are STILL AT RISK will <u>NOT</u> attend SENIOR FUNCTIONS.

Attendance & Credits

- Days are accruing only allowed 9 for the entire semester before you owe hours
- If you owe hours OR credits, be aware they are due by May 18th,
 2019.
- If you attend Saturday School, you MUST have homework.
- In order to receive double hours, you must stay for the entire 4 hours.
- You WILL NOT graduate if you owe hours or credits.

If you have questions about attendance hours, see Mr. Torres




Class Rank and GPA

Final class rank and GPAs will be distributed during A and B lunch on April 26th, 2019

- •The 6th six week grading period **still counts**
 - oGrades will be posted on your final transcript for colleges/universities to see.
 - You must have a passing semester grade in order to receive credit for the class.
 - ■60 is not a passing grade in PAP or AP classes...you must have a 70.

- Guidelines
 - Be sure to arrive by no later than 4:45pm.

BOYS FORMAL ATTIRE


Formal prom attire may be classified as a tuxedo or dress suit, including a tie, bow tie, a turtle neck, a shirt, which may include a vest or cummerbund.

Bust Line (on the side)




This dress meets dress code.

Dresses may be backless as long as they are not cut below the naval.






These dresses meet the dress code.


